This census is very important. Please complete and return it as soon as possible.

The Minnesota State Legislature requires every public school district to take and maintain an annual census of its birth to 21 population.

This information is very important to our district:

- ◆ Information from the census is used to project enrollment, staffing needs, facility use and transportation routes.
- ◆ Emergency numbers and names listed on the census are used by the elementary, middle school and high school offices for emergencies.
- ◆ Early Childhood Screening of every 3-4 year old in the district is required by state law and parents need to be contacted for appointments.
- ◆ State funding for the Early Childhood Family Education program and School Readiness is based on certified numbers of children, birth to 5 not yet in kindergarten, living in the district.
- ◆ Young people may continue to receive special services from the district until age 21.
