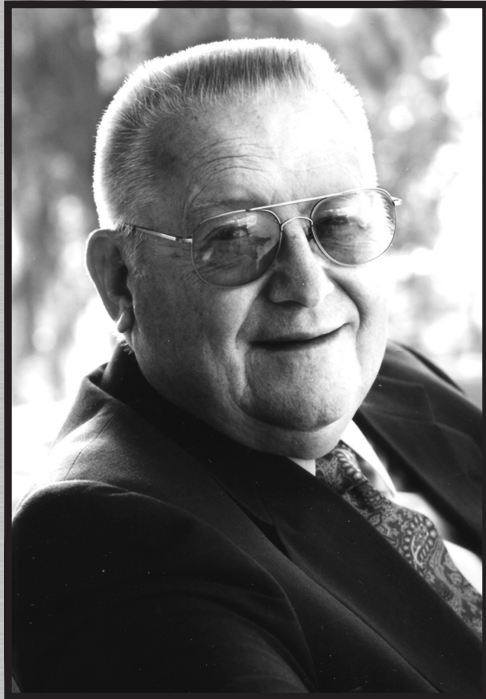




HOWARD LAKE-WAVERLY-WINSTED

Curt Levang



Curt Levang came to Howard Lake in 1970 and cemented his family into the community to start his career as the Elementary Principal of the Howard Lake School District. The following year Waverly became part of the school district. His career spanned 26 years and included special services and support for the Winsted Elementary School. At his retirement in 1996 Winsted officially joined the school district. His career in education lasted 38 years.

His involvement and support for others extended beyond the school district. In 2005, he was awarded the Virginia McKnight Binger Award in Human Services for support of children and families. Curt was more than just a principal for the two elementary schools he directed. He was a counselor, social worker, provider, and advocate of the school district, community, families, and students. Curt's generosity with his time and resources is unending. His love for the school district and community can be witnessed to this day, as he is often out and about in the community offering his friendly conversation to all, and through his attendance at many sporting events and activities.

Curt's work with scholarships at HLWW may be his most notable work. Through his hard work and dedication, Curt has kept track of and overseen over 22 scholarships over several years. Since 2001, these scholarships have awarded nearly \$500,000 to HLWW graduates.
